The meeting was called to order by Kaitlyn Hathorn at 12:02 pm

- 1. Welcome and Introductions:** Each Coalition member reported who they were and their role in the community.
- 2. Monthly Report:** Erin reviewed the monthly report. Some highlights from this month included; the RX. Drug take back, and coalition members and staff submitting comments to the ALAC and City Council. In reviewing the Strategic Prevention Framework, the category “enhancing skills” has declined. This is because many of the Youth 2 Youth for Change activities have not been held during the pandemic. No other questions or concerns at this time.
- 3. Upcoming City Council Action:** The city council will be voting on the class A liquor license quota at their next meeting. Please consider submitting citizen comments. City staff is recommending that there be no Class A license quota. The ALAC is recommending that there be a cap at 26 class A licenses with a possible extension if the business can show economic benefit to the city. Erin will email out the procedure on how to submit citizen comments. Mark mentioned to sign your comments as a private citizen or from your place of employment so all the comments are not coming for JM4C.
- 4. Virtual Reality Maze:** Jane has been working with the health teachers at all three middle schools to plan and implement a virtual reality maze this spring. Eighth and Ninth grade students would be invited to attend an online platform through the website Typeform. Students would go through scenarios with uploaded videos of school staff, police, health, parents, juvenile justice and AODA counselors. Students would complete

a quiz at the end. Jenny offered to record a video of her daughter's story. Cost of the Typeform platform would be \$35 a month. We could pay for three months. Jane is looking for volunteers to record videos and will also be reaching out to numerous agencies for help with the videos

5. **CADCA Leadership Forum:** Erin is asking if anyone would like to attend the CADCA Leadership Forum that starts February 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Forum runs from 10:00 am to 5:15 pm M-Thur. that week. This all online. Please contact Erin soon if you are interested in attending. JM4C will pay for the conference.
  
6. **Applications to the Board:** Would you like to be a board member? Please visit the City of Janesville website and fill out an application. All completed applications will be sent to Erin at JM4C.
  
7. **Sexual Violence Grant update:** The grant committee has been working on policy analysis and currently have 12 active organizations meeting. The committee will be launching a consent campaign starting January 25<sup>th</sup>. There will be 4 different billboards at 23 different locations throughout Rock County. Xandi will share the billboard graphics with the coalition to share on their social media pages if they feel comfortable. The committee has also been working on increasing committee membership, especially with college age young adults. The committee has reached out to Blackhawk Technical College, UWW- Rock County and Beloit College. Committee meeting times are 2pm on Wednesdays if you know a young adult to invite.
