The meeting was called to order by Erin Davis at 12:00 pm

- 1. Welcome and Icebreaker:** What is your favorite color?
- 2. Monthly Report:** no concerns, questions or discussion
- 3. Marijuana Actions:** Erin, Jay and Kathy met with the Better Brodhead coalition to discuss their work with a group called SAM (Smart Approaches to Marijuana). After investigation and discussion, it seems as if there would be an extensive list of expectations to work with this group. It was decided that an alliance with SAM could possibly put our DFC grant in jeopardy because the activities could cross over into lobbying. Erin has scheduled a meeting with Dorothy Chaney from the State of Wisconsin to discuss suggestions on where to focus our efforts on marijuana prevention for youth.
- 4. Alcohol Actions:** Jane gave an update on an underage drinking prevention campaign called "Small Talks". The campaign will focus on how parents can talk to their children about underage drinking. This is a State run campaign and will be done in collaboration with other drug free coalitions. Jane is looking for help to distribute yard signs. Jane will approach the School District of Janesville to place yard signs on school properties.

Julia Sherman held an Alcohol Policy 101 workshop for the Janesville city council and the ALAC. There was a discussion on coming up with an Alcohol Action Plan for the city of Janesville. There will be a meeting scheduled to review the alcohol ordinances and discuss next steps on writing a city plan on September 28th, 2020.

- 5. Hidden in Plain Sight Virtual Display:** JATV recoded a presentation of Hidden in Plain Sight in August. JM4C will create a FB event for community members to view the presentation. People will register for the event and Jane will send them a Link to watch the presentation. This will be a 15-minute presentation. This presentation will also be shown to coalition at our next meeting.
- 6. Cultural Competency Training:** a review and discussion on our current board training. The board felt the training was beneficial. Part three of the training called "Building Relationships" will be held on **November 4th from 1-3 pm**. Erin will send out the Link as the training gets closer.
